Reception

► *Play to find answers to the questions written on your Placecard.*

► *Since there are no Names, the Extended family sheet should help you make sense of relationships. You can look at it whenever you need to.*

► *Give the Veteran a Memento and its Signal only when another Relative encourages you to do so.*

► *Remember to always give Signals in increasing numerical order, from I up to IV.*

► *Reject as lies the Messages from the Veteran when they come with a Memento.*

► *Accept as intimate truths the Messages from the Veteran with no Memento attached.*

Transmission

► *Choose a single Relative to pair up with for the current phase.*

► *Use this moment to vent instead of focusing on comforting the others.*

Epilogue

► *Once the Veteran speaks the Name, keep quiet and follow his lead.*

► *Line up with the other Relatives. You will get to bid the Fallen farewell through gestures alone.*
